

Our topic will continue to be “Markets and Money”.

In communication we will continue working on extending our shared attention and using our preferred means of communication to make requests and communicate our needs and wants with increasing independence. Our book for this term will be “The Enormous Turnip”. All students will continue to participate in phonics sessions throughout the week.

We will continue our communication groups; some will be taking part in attention bucket sessions and some will take part in a writing session. We will all be working on answering who, what and where questions.

In Maths we are working on continuing a pattern and being able to identify objects that are tall/short and heavy/light. We will continue to work on our numbers, some working on the concept that when items move around the number stays the same, others will be working on addition and subtraction to 20 and others to continue to work on their times tables.

In Science, our topic will be forces, we will explore toys/objects that are magnetic and explore magnets in different experiments.

In Geography we will recognise features of markets through role play and visits to markets. In History we will be looking at shops and seeing if they might be the same or different to the shops we would see in the past. We will explore the clothes and compare pictures of ourselves with pictures of people from the past to look for similarities and differences.

In SMEH, our focus will be on identifying how we are feeling and sharing it with others and for some to begin to give a reason why they might be feeling that way.
