Our topic will continue to be “The Great Outdoors”.

In communication we will continue working on extending our shared attention and using our preferred means of communication to make requests and communicate our needs and wants with increasing independence. Our book for this term will be “We`re Going on a Bear Hunt”. All students will continue to participate in phonics sessions throughout the week.

We will continue our communication groups; some students will be taking part in attention bucket sessions. Some will take part in a writing session. All students will use writing utensils to make marks. We will all be working on asking and answering who, what and where questions and following instructions.

In Maths we are continuing our work on numbers. Some of us will be working on one and more, some on identifying one more and one less than a number up to 5, some on number bonds to 20 and some will be working on partitioning numbers into tens and ones. We will be working on sequencing the events in our day to morning, afternoon and evening. Some of us will continue working on 0`clock times and begin to work on recognising these times when written in 24 hour times.

In Science our topic will be plants. We will plant seeds and learn to look after them as they grow. We will explore what plants needs to grow and the different parts of a plant.

In Geography we will be learning to recognise the world around our School. We will do this by using maps. In History we will explore our local community and find similarities and differences to what Kingston looked like in the past compared to now.

In Art we will be creating 3D structures from junk modelling and Lego/ Duplo. In DT we will explore a range of different foods and food hygiene.

We will continue to work on identifying how we are feeling and be able to give a reason from a choice. We will begin to think of strategies that might help us to feel calm.
