

In the Summer Term our topic will be 'The Great Outdoors'. In Summer 1 we will be bringing learning outside as much as possible. We will also be bringing the outside in exploring plants, identifying their names and labelling parts of plants. Elephants will be using their senses to take in the variety of colours, smells and textures of flowers and plants and creating 3D models of the plants found using clay and a number of different materials. Elephants will be learning how to grow their own plants and what is needed to take care of them. Elephants will further explore what food grows on plants and make yummy fruit and vegetable recipes. The class text for the half term will be 'What a Wonderful World' by Bob Thiele (Author), George David Weiss (Author), Tim Hopgood (Illustrator). Elephants will continue deepening their understanding of number and look at creating number bonds of 10. Fruit and vegetables will be used to help the understanding that 1 whole is part of 2 halves.
