In Communication our focus this term is to be able to give and follow instructions and for students to initiate requests or ask for help. We are focusing on being able to answer who, what and where questions this term, with increasing independence. and Our story this term will be "The Enormous Turnip" which we will do once a week. Giraffes will also be taking part in attention bucket session once a week. We will have discrete phonic sessions daily this term. All the students will read to an adult and have the chance to listen to a range of different stories throughout the week.

In Maths we are developing our understanding of number. Some of us will be working on number bonds to 10 and counting numbers accurately consistently to 15 and 10. Another group will be working on number bonds to 20, and being able to identify the time when written in 24-hour format. We will all be working on sequencing, being able to order the days of the week and know what day was yesterday and today.

In Science, our topic for this term is light and we will be exploring different light toys and try to identify light sources both within school and the local community. We will understand the importance of having light.

In History we will recognise people who are important to us. We will then explore people who are important to us in the local community, such as the police. In SEMH, we will be working on being able to share with others something that we are good at.
