Our communication focus this term is to be able to give and follow instructions and for students to initiate requests or ask for help. We are concentrating on being able to answer who, what and where questions with increasing independence. We will do our story for this term once a week and this time around we have chosen "Rapunzel".

We will have discrete phonic sessions daily during the term and all of the students will read to an adult and have the chance to listen to a range of different stories throughout the week.

In maths, we are developing our understanding of numbers. We will be working on addition and subtraction and writing these number sums. Some will be working on multiplication using the 2-times table.

In science, our topic for this term continues to be light and we will be exploring different light toys and the ability to identify light sources, both within school and the local community. We will be able to identify objects that are opaque and objects that are transparent through experiments.

In Geography, we will be looking at maps and making our own sensory maps of the local area. Additionally, we will start to explore compass directions north, south, east and west. In history we will learn about the Great Fire of London.
