Our theme for this term will be “the circle of life”.

In Communication our focus for the term will be for students to initiate requests with increasing independence and we will be focusing on being able to ask and answer who, what and where questions. Our class story for this term will be “Giraffes can’t dance”.

We will continue to have discrete phonic sessions daily and within these sessions we will work on blending to read words, spelling words and reading words in a sentence. We will be learning to read tricky words and writing CVC and CVCC words.

In Maths we will be developing our understanding and concept of number. We will continue to work on measurement, some of us will explore length and others weight. We will explore 2D shapes to identify properties, such as the number of sides, and explore symmetry on a common 2D shape. Some of us will look at the time, looking at 0`clock and half past times.

In Science, our topic for this term will continue to be sound. We will be doing lots of experiments and making predictions.

In Geography we will be looking at maps and learning about directions and we will be exploring using a compass and map.

In History, we will be learning about famous people from the past and the jobs that they did.
