

In English and Communication, we will be exploring the story “The Very Hungry Caterpillar” linking to this term’s topic “The Circle of Life”. The story will allow all of the pupils to use all of the senses. We will also be reading and taking part in other stories such as “We’re Going on a Weather Hunt - A Sensory Story”. In Spring Term 1, we started working on attention activities and turn-taking activities and we will carry this through into Spring Term 2. In Maths, we will be continuing to explore numbers but also shapes, measure and identifying heavy and light items. We will be doing this in focused and whole group sessions and linking our learning to our class story.

In Science we will be continuing to investigate sounds, linking them to key vocabulary. We will continue to explore sound bottles and conduct scientific investigations. The investigations will be looking at different materials and what happens when we place them on top of instruments and sound bottles. During this term, we will be taking part of our Science learning outdoors.

In Humanities subjects, we will be exploring more of our world around us by identifying changes in our environment and going into the community. In Art, we will be exploring luminous colours and in DT continue to investigate bridges by using soft blocks and recycled materials. We will be aiming to explore more of our local town centre and continue to work on our preferred method of communication.
