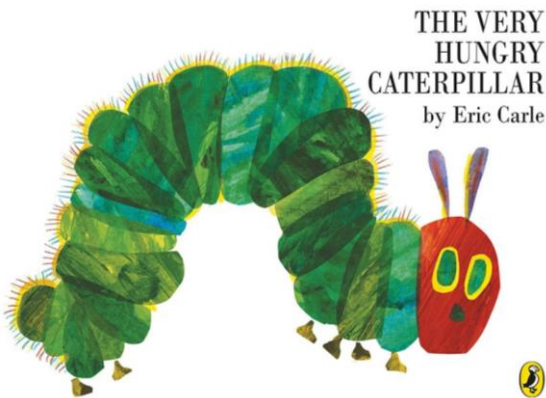

We will learn new vocabulary and signs for this topic, as well as use our creativity to make caterpillars out of playdough or make butterflies using symmetric painting techniques. We will also have special events such as “World Book Day”, or preparing our performance for the Easter Service at St. John’s Church towards the end of our term.
