

In English and Communication, we will be exploring the stories “Clean Up” and “The Messy Magpie” linking to this term’s topic “Oceans of the World”. The stories will allow all pupils to use all senses and focus on making class discussions about families and ways that we can look after our planet. We will also continue to master using switches and symbols such as yes, no, more, finish, your turn and my turn, but also to greet friends and support staff. We have begun to explore letters and sounds during morning greetings and will continue to explore the first letter of our names through textural exploration and mark making.

In Maths we will be continuing to explore numbers to 20 through songs, chants, number lines and counting different objects relating to this term’s topic. We are going to support our counting through the use of number lines and begin to use “more” and “less”. We looked at different shapes throughout Spring but we will also continue to explore 3D shapes.

In Science we will be exploring different animals by initially looking at different sea animals that link to our class story to be able to compare them to pet and home animals. To support our learning we will be recreating different habitats such as a Hippo’s and learn new animals’ names!

In Humanities subjects, we will be learning about the King’s Coronation through role play and multi-sensory lessons but also making links to 5 British Values. In Art, we will be exploring different artworks by Pablo Picasso to create different textural artworks that explore pattern and shapes alongside DT in continuing to explore soft and hard fabrics. We aim to explore more of our local town centre and continue to work on our preferred method of communication. Lastly, we will have more mat and movement PE sessions to continue to support and develop our strengths.
