In Communication, our focus for the term will be for students to be able to answer and ask questions with increased independence. Our class story for this term will be a collection of poems on sea creatures called, "Commotion in the Ocean". We will work as a class to create our own class poem based on this.

In Phonics, we will continue to have our discrete daily sessions during the course of the term. Within these sessions, we will work on blending to read words, spelling words and reading words in a sentence. We are also learning to read tricky words and writing CVC and CVCC words. Giraffe Class will then be working on applying our phonic knowledge to reading and identifying words in our environment and choosing or writing words.

In Maths, we are developing our understanding and concept of numbers. Some of us will be working on identifying one more and one less than a number up to 20. Others will be working on writing addition number sums to 20, adding a 2 digit and a 1-digit number and then some will be working on multiplication of 2 times table up to 20.

In Science, our topic for this term will be animals. Giraffes will be exploring 3 different types of animals and mini beasts. Following this, we will learn to identify some of them and then explore the habitats they live in. We will explore animals that live in the sea and then we will explore pets and the animals that Giraffe Class have at home.

In History, we will be researching the Romans, whereby we will discover what their houses looked like, the jobs they did and what they wore.
